




Our most frequently enrolled training is the basic life support training for both non-healthcare workers and healthcare workers. The training prepares you to carry out effective CPR, use defibrillators safely and how to help choking victims.

We work with organizations, schools, estates, religious organizations etc to build a strong CHAIN OF SURVIVAL by training and putting plans in place where people survive collapses rather than dying.

In collaboration with partners, we trained 125 students and 22 teachers in Kwara State on the 12th of December 2023. The training involved selected students from 11 schools across the state. The aim of the training was to equip students with life saving skills to perform CPR effectively, teaching them to recognize cardiac emergencies as well as other life threatening emergencies and how to respond quickly, building confidence and improve understanding for students to act decisively in emergency situations and facilitate community engagement initiatives by encouraging students to share their knowledge and skills with others in their communities.

CAREGIVERS TRAINING



In 2023, we have trained 44 persons, 18 years and above to become CPD UK certified caregivers. Our caregiving training is certified by CPD UK and students traveling abroad for postgraduate degrees have taken advantage of this scheme to aid getting a job as carers while studying.

This training can be done by any adult regardless of their educational background or prior knowledge of healthcare job. It teaches students core competencies required to work in healthcare spaces in developed countries.

There are 20 modules to be covered within 4 days and a reflective diary assessment, to be completed before certification.

With the certification, participants are able to seek caregivers job in hospitals, healthcare facilities, Nursing homes, Geriatric Homes, Home Care Service and any other area that requires an assistant in health and social care.

It is a 4-days intensive training which could be done physically or virtually with an additional optional 1 - day physical Basic Life Support training certificated by European Resuscitation Council.

DFO MASTERCLASS SERIES

Dr. Femi Ogunremi (DFO) monthly MasterClass series flagged off in May 2023. The DFO series was started as a highly subsidised CSR project to contribute to quality improvement in Nigeria healthcare system. This is an online training for healthcare providers to teach and share experiences in Quality Improvement. The cost per participant was subsidized heavily to give everyone the opportunity to attend and learn. So far, 7 series have been carried out and over 400 health care personnels! however our target is to provide equitable opportunity for all healthcare providers across Nigeria. FIRST AID TRAINING

Accidents happen often when they are not expected. Such can be an injury or illness. Usually, what is done immediately following the injury determines the longstanding effect of the accident. First aid is the initial assessment and intervention that is given to victims following such injury or illness to prevent suffering and reduce further damages or disability.

An emergency situation calls for first aid intervention by a trained and possibly certified first aider. This may occur at workplaces, homes, communities or even at a social gatherings.





MEDICAL SCREENINGS



Our flagship project in MHL is the screening of Non-Communicable Diseases (NCD) across genders and all ages. We have innovated around screening in Nigeria and we have mad palpable impacts. This year we have carried out screening programmes across various states in Nigeria. Earlier on in the year, we screened over **18,500** people in Lagos State alone. We screened against, Breast Cancer using BREAST-i device, Cervical cancer, Prostate Cancer, Eye problems, Diabetes, Hypertension, Retroviral disease and more.

NCD encompass a range of chronic conditions that tend to progress slowly over time. These include cardiovascular diseases (such as heart disease and stroke), cancer, respiratory diseases (like chronic obstructive pulmonary disease), and diabetes, among others. They are usually long-lasting and often require ongoing management and care.

Several factors contribute to the development of NCDs. Unhealthy lifestyle choices, such as a lack of physical activity, poor nutrition, tobacco use, and excessive alcohol consumption, significantly increase the risk of NCDs. Additionally, genetic predisposition, environmental factors (such as pollution and exposure to harmful substances), and socioeconomic factors can influence the likelihood of developing these diseases.

Timely detection and screening can lead to the early identification of NCD and a great chance to be cured and prevents complications. Regular medical check-ups, screenings aid early intervention and management. We encourage our clients to get checked every year during their birthday.

We plan to move up the numbers from our current 10,248 lives to 30,000+ in the new year!

1. BLS TRAINING IN BORNO STATE



Borno State is one of the states badly affected by the Boko Haram insurgence in nigeria. There has been a lot of casualties and the state government is keen on improving the quality of care received by the people. Basic Life Support (BLS) was one of the plan to empower the healthcare workers in the state with the view of improving the quality of care delivered. Attendees were trained on effective CPR, managing choking, how to use Automated External Defibrillators safely and positioning patients in recovery positions.



We had 2 days of impactful learning for 150 frontline workers in the state. The process of bringing these hardworking staff to Maiduguri was rigorous in view of the concerns around security issues in the area. The Basic Life Support training was delivered to all registaterd staff from 27 local government areas. Some had to rush back for time because of security alert!



Similar to our work in other states, we have worked with the Health Management Board lead by the CMD (Prof. Kolima) and other members of the planning committee to put together a workable logistic despite the complexity involve. The feedback from the training shows a great impact in skill gained.

We have the honour of the SA Health to the presidency (Dr. Salma Ibrahim Anas) and the Deputy Governor of the state to flag the training.



2. FIRST AID TRAINING FOR AXA MANSARD NIG



MHL work with various organizations to meet their training needs. As part of our work in this space, we have worked with multiple health oriented organizations such as Axa Mansard.

We carried out a day of First Aid training for frontline officers for Axa Mansard. It was a well planned and structured training.

Our engagements normally start with need assessment where we work with the training lead in organization. Then setting the training modules to bridge the knowledge gaps identified.





Following the training, we offer international certifications and support the organization in further need assessment and audit of impact. Our training is well sought after and we are keen to engage more partners or organizations that value trainings in impacting their productivity.

Our First Aid training is unique and it well structured to identify and bridge knowledge gap appropriate to the needs of your team. We have packages for different groups depending on needs e.g, the modules for First Aid in estate is not same as First Aid in an organization although, there are overlaps.

Our goal is to work with local and international partners to deliver healthcare at an affordable rate and in style. We work with Federal Government parastatals to deliver medical mission to communities. We have delivered impactful medical outreaches to at Agege Lagos Federal Constituency providing health screening to over 10,000 residents!

Free medical tests for HIV, blood sugar level, blood pressure, breast screening and cervical screenings, dental check and deworming for children were provided for all who were present for exercise. Health counselling alon side free consultation with medical doctors and free prescriptions afterwards was carried out for all . Over 10,000 persons were reached via on-air messages.

A total of four sites in Agege communities were used for the outreach and 6 schools for dental and deworming exersices.





The impact of this exercise was palpable, people with abnormal screening reports were treated and follow up arranged for some in local hospitals and clinics.

Positive patients were referred to tertiary care for further assessment and care. We also had to follow up via phone calls and text messages which proved successful.

MHL is know to work on collaborations like this to bring impactful and innovative care to communities. We have worked in Surulere and other constituencies across the state.




